## **GREETINGS FROM PRAIRIE HOME HOSPICE**

Over the past 12 months, Prairie Home Hospice, like most other nonprofit organizations, has been affected by the economy. We have needed to tighten our belt on expenditures and try and come up with ways to increase our revenue. We are also facing reductions in reimbursement from Medicare and Medical Assistance. For over 25 years, people and businesses in our area have generously supported us and we are extremely grateful. Unfortunately, we will continue to rely on this generous support as we move forward in to a new fiscal year beginning in July.

In the business of providing hospice services, the majority of our expenses are directly related to patient care, such as staff, medications, medical supplies and equipment, etc. These are expenses that we can't change a whole lot. We are looking for ways to be more efficient with our time and resources, but it would be difficult to make many reductions without impacting the level of services being provided.

We have been looking to reduce expenses that do not impact direct service to patients and families, two of which are postage and printing. We currently have over 2,800 individuals and businesses on our mailing list. We have already reduced the number of times we publish our newsletter from four times a year to three. It currently costs us over \$1,100 each time we print and mail a newsletter. We feel it is extremely important to keep you all up-to-date and informed of what is going on with Prairie Home Hospice, but are looking at alternative ways to get this information out to you. We would like to encourage each of you to sign up to receive the newsletter via e-mail instead of by mail if at all possible. We would greatly appreciate it if you could contact us if you would like to receive your newsletter via email, need to correct a name or address, or if you no longer wish to be on our mailing list. The more information we can distribute via email, the more timely and accurate we can be, and the more money and resources we will save. Thanks so much for your help with this!

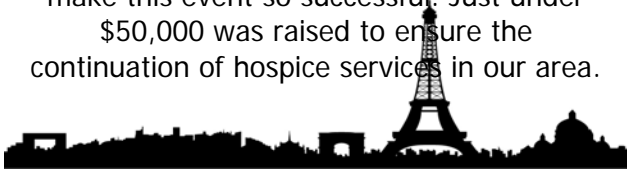
